BLACK ADVOCATES FOR LIFE POLL RESULTS

The survey was conducted October 11-13. The margin of error, with a 95% confidence interval, was 4.0%. The party registration of respondents was 83-3% Democratic (14% Independents). The geographic breakdown of the respondents was as follows: 3% from Alexandria, 23% from Baton Rouge, 12% from Lafayette, 4% from Lake Charles, 8% from Monroe, 36% from New Orleans, and 14% from Shreveport.
