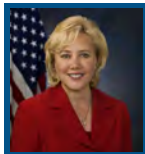


Louisiana U.S. Senate Election 2014

Where Do the Candidates Stand on Life?

Incumbent: Senator Mary Landrieu (D)
Complete Voting Record in Congress: 27% Pro-Life
Voting Record Since Re-Election: 0 % Pro-Life



Since 1997, Landrieu has cast 17 out of 63 votes pro-life in the Senate, giving her a 27% pro-life voting record. Since re-election in 2008, Landrieu has cast 0/15 votes pro-life, giving her a 0% pro-life voting record since re-election.

Challenger: Congressman Bill Cassidy (R)
Complete Voting Record in Congress: 100% Pro-Life
Voting Record Since Re-Election: 100% Pro-Life



Since 2009, Cassidy has cast 19 out of 19 votes pro-life in Congress, giving him a 100% pro-life voting record.
