
Abortions Reported in 2018 - **8,097** | Abortions Reported in 2017 - **8,706**This represents a **7 percent** decrease from the previous year.

QUICK FACTS


- There were 8,097 abortions performed in Louisiana in 2018. That means there were, on average, 22 abortions per day.
- 18 girls under the age of 15 had abortions in Louisiana in 2018. Another 721 girls between the ages of 15-19 aborted their babies.
- The largest number of abortions 2,400 were performed on women between the ages of 20-24. Women ages 25-29 were right behind at 2,399. There were also 1,051 women ages 35 and older who had abortions in Louisiana in 2018.
- African-American women accounted for 61% of abortions performed in Louisiana in 2018.
- 86% of women who had abortions in 2018 were unmarried.
- 67% of babies were aborted within eight weeks of pregnancy.
- Out-of-state residents accounted for 13 percent (1,083) of all abortions performed in Louisiana. The list of states where these women came from is not available at this time.
