ABORTION

NO ONE CAN FORCE YOU TO HAVE AN ABORTION:
NOT YOUR PARENTS,
YOUR PARTNER, OR YOUR BOSS.
IF YOU ARE BEING THREATENED OR COERCED,
YOU CAN CALL 911 IMMEDIATELY.

ABORTION CAN HURT YOU

Common side-effects of abortion include hemorrhaging, uterine puncture and tearing, infection from retained tissue, and even the inability to carry another child to term and the possibility of breast cancer.

Following an abortion women can experience depression, intense grief and suicidal thoughts. Likelihood of Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), increased substance abuse, and experience difficulty in relationships.

ABORTION HURTS YOUR BABY

MEDICAL ABORTION

Abortion by pill involves chemicals (Mifeprex) that weaken the lining of your uterus and cause the starvation and eventual death of your baby. The pills you will be prescribed include chemicals (Misoprostol) that will cause strong contractions, bleeding, and the expulsion of the baby while you are at home.

SURGICAL ABORTION

During your aspiration abortion, the baby is torn from the uterus and sucked into a tube, either whole or in pieces. But when the baby's tissues and bones are more developed, the baby is first sliced up with a sharp instrument to aid aspiration. A surgical abortion may require forceps to grasp, twist, tear apart, and remove the baby's body piece by piece.
