The Youth Programs Director will collaborate with LARTL Staff, including the other Youth Programs Director headquartered in Lafayette

Qualities Needed:

- Experience and Knowledge Recommended: Prior experience in following activities is recommended:
 - Pro-Life activities and a solid foundation of pro-life principles
 - Students for Life experience on high school and/orcollege campuses
 - Youth Ministry
- Self-Starter: The employee would be required to be self-driven to set and reach goals without constant monitoring.

Terms of Employment:

- The position will be a full-time (at least 40 hours a week) salaried position.
- The starting salary of the employee will depend on the candidate and their experience.
- Initial benefits would include:
 - Health, Dental, and Vision Employee Subsidized Plans
 - Monthly Mobile Phone Stipend
 - 10 Business Days Paid Vacation (accrued ratably over a year's period). Vacation days would increase depending on the number of years the employee is on staff.
 - Paid Sick Time
 - Retirement Plan
- The Youth Programs Co-Director will work out of the New Orleans office of the organization (200 Allen Toussaint Blvd New Orleans, LA 70124) or any other location the organization so approves.
- The employee will be reimbursed for reasonable expenses (mileage, purchases, etc.) incurred while working for the organization.

- Secure and give presentations in elementary schools, high schools, colleges, and churches in the Greater New Orleans area and other locations as needed.
